

FAQ

What do I wear?

This is an outdoor show, please check weather forecasts and dress appropriately. You will be walking, so ensure you have sturdy and warm footwear.

Will there be seating?

There will be no seating. We will distribute seat pads which can be placed on the ground, or you are free to bring a cushion or blanket to sit on. Please note the ground may be wet. You are welcome to bring a 'shooting stick' to stand / lean on, please be circumspect of other people behind you.

Can I bring a camping chair?

No. Please don't.

What if it rains or storms?

The performance will take place in the rain up to a point.

Please be prepared for rain with waterproof clothing. Rain falling on umbrellas can drown out the sound for you and the view for other people. If there are high winds the performance may have to be cancelled, due to the danger to both audience and performers. In this case the organiser will reimburse your ticket, or if possible we will try and allocate you a place another night.

Can I bring a buggy?

The ground around the performance site is uneven, and the exit to the car park is via set of steep steps. (see below)

What is the access to the performance site?

The performance takes place in the woodlands, therefore the ground may be uneven in places, and it is dark. There are a number of steps leading from the performance site back to the car park. There is no alternative way back to the car park. There is no independent wheelchair access to the performance site.

What if I'm late?

Please aim to arrive 15mins before the show starts.

There are stewards available to guide you to the performance site.

How do I get my tickets?

You should purchase your tickets in advance of the event. You can then collect your tickets from The Capitol or have them posted to you for a small charge of £1. You can also select the 'Print at Home' option, where an e-ticket will be delivered to you via email. If necessary, this can be displayed on your phone but the individual barcodes on each ticket should be visible enough to be scanned on site. There is **no facility to collect or purchase tickets on site at Leonardslee** so please ensure you are in possession of a valid ticket before attending the performance.
